Ackworth School, a co-educational boarding and day school, was founded in 1779 by the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers). It maintains its ethos and traditions and is still governed by the Society although only a small number of pupils and staff are from the Quaker tradition. The school is academically non-selective and provides an excellent range of facilities and extra-curricular opportunities. The school is a member of both HMC and Society of Heads.

We are looking to appoint a full time HLTA to our junior school, Coram House, from September 2019.

The candidate must hold a relevant qualification and have sufficient experience at this level to include teaching classes during planned absences and to cover for PPA time. Candidates will be expected to cover from EYFS to KS2.

Applicants should also be in sympathy with the Quaker Ethos.
