## **SCHOOL NURSE (TERM TIME ONLY) – JANUARY 2023**

Ackworth School, a co-educational boarding and day school, was founded in 1779 by the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers). It maintains its ethos and traditions and is still governed by the Society although only a small number of pupils and staff are from the Quaker tradition. The school is academically non-selective and provides an excellent range of facilities and extra-curricular opportunities. The school is a member of both HMC and the Society of Heads.

Ackworth School is seeking to appoint an experienced School Nurse to support both Junior and Senior School and the pupils who board with us.

The ideal candidate must have paediatric nursing experience. Whilst independent school experience is not essential, it will be advantageous. The role is very much stand-alone therefore the post holder must possess sufficient experience and knowledge to make immediate decisions, without the need to refer.

We are looking for someone who is not just reactive to medical requirements but who very much takes a pro-active approach to the health and well-being of the entire School.

The role is term time only plus an additional week, although some flexibility may be required. The salary for the role is circa £27,055 to £33,706 FTE (£21,066- £26,246 actual) In addition to this the school provides all meals during working hours in term time. The working hours are 37.5 per week.
