

Teacher of Design Technology/Food & Nutrition

Ackworth School is seeking to appoint an enthusiastic and dynamic teacher of Design Technology and Food and Nutrition. Design Technology is taught throughout the School from NC Y6 to A Level; Food and Nutrition is currently taught from NC Y6 to GCSE Level. The ideal applicant must have high teaching standards and sound subject knowledge, enabling them to teach throughout the school. A willingness to contribute positively to the department, both within and beyond the classroom, is essential.

The role could be split into separate subject areas, of approximately 0.7 of a timetable each. For a suitably qualified candidate, able to teach in both subject areas, a full time role could be created. This would then result in a part time role of approximately 0.4 of a full timetable being available. There is also the opportunity to pick up some ICT lessons for KS3, to make a full time position - these could be added to either Design Technology or Food and Nutrition.

We are willing to consider applications from NQTs for these roles and would welcome the new perspective that a suitable candidate could bring to the department and the wider school. There is also a vacancy in each of the Boys' and Girls' Boarding Houses for an Assistant House Parent. Accommodation in School is available in both Houses, though applications for non-residential staff would also be considered (a duty flat is available for nights on duty).
